

Future prospects of Garden Route Fynbos uncertain 04 April 2024



Conservationists and environmental management entities in the Garden Route share concern on the dual effect of climate change, expanding agricultural practices and rapid development on what remains of the region's Fynbos species.

"These fynbos species are on the Red List of Terrestrial Ecosystems (Government Notice 2747), many of which are critically endangered and unlikely to survive, given their limited prospects in isolation and all present threats," says Cobus Meiring of the Garden Route Environmental Forum (GREF).

An old pine tree was recently blown down off Andries Pretorius Street into the garden of Vygieshof, causing much damage to their garden. A request by Vygieshof for some assistance with replacing two missing trees, and adding a few more elsewhere on the property, was answered by Calitzdorp Community Chest - Calitzdorp Gemeenskapskas. The CCC funded six indigenous trees from Oudtshoorn and, on Freedom Day, they were planted by Community Chest and the Vygieshof members. One day a giant Apiesdoring (Acacia galpinii) will stand in splendour in the place of the old pine tree.

THE 36ONE MTB CHALLENGE | 24 - 26 May 2024




This is South Africa's ultimate race with 361km and a maximum of 36.1 hours to complete it. Starting with a neutral zone, riders head out of town from Kleinplaas Holiday Resort, turning right onto the first gravel section towards De Zeekoe, where the official start of the 189km race is located. The riders head in a westerly direction towards the northern sections of the great Gouritz river. Sharper steeper sections find its way to the southerly slopes of the Rooiberg Mountain – with around 70 km in the legs, this bump in the road feels quite severe.

The descent usually coincides with sunrise over Calitzdorp, the port capital of South Africa. Sun on the back and home sweet home in sight makes the narrow farm roads past Groenfontein and Kruisrivier seem easier – undulations and fast downhills bring riders ever closer to Oudtshoorn past Lategansvlei – 189 kilometres done and dusted!

The Station is at the end of a most delightful street of period houses with the formidable NGKerk at the other end.



Early morning we saw the Cape Eagle-Owl just before we left The Station. The Previous evening we were entertained by the Barn Owl(Nonnetjies uil) family of 4 and their little chicks screaming for food. That was so cool!

We left quite early the The Station - Calitzdorp, Western Cape and popped in at De Krans for breakfast and stopped at Boplaas Winery for a few bottles of premium whisky and brandy.

On our way to Oudtshoorn, Western Cape Oudtshoorn (/ˈaʊtshɔːrn/, Afrikaans pronunciation: [ˈəuts huərən]), the "ostrich capital of the world",[3]

Oudtshoorn (/ˈaʊtshɔːrn/, Afrikaans pronunciation: [ˈəutsˌɦuərən]), the "ostrich capital of the world",[3] is a town in the Western Cape province of South Africa, located between the Swartberg mountains to the north and the Outeniqua Mountains to the south. Two ostrich-feather booms, during 1865–1870 and 1900–1914, truly established the settlement.[4] With approximately 60,000 inhabitants, it is the largest town in the Little Karoo region. The town's economy is primarily reliant on the ostrich farming and tourism industries.[5] Oudtshoorn is home to the world's largest ostrich population,[6] with a number of specialised ostrich breeding farms, such as the Safari Show Farm and the Highgate Ostrich Show Farm, as told by Mnr. Pierre D. Toit

58. Vegetation types around Calitzdorp - Apronveld

One aspect of our plant world around Calitzdorp that we have not touched upon yet is the classification of the vegetation types or plant associations that occur in the vicinity of the town. Jan and Anne Lise Vlok, in their book *Plants of the Klein Karoo*, provide descriptions of the vegetation types of the Klein Karoo, with accompanying maps. I thought we could expand a little on their description with some photos of typical plants to illustrate it.

The Vloks describe Apronveld as occurring on "gentle lower slopes of ridges and hills, where the soils are loamy or clayey, with a fair amount of surface rock." Which means that most of the area surrounding Calitzdorp falls into the Apronveld category. Apronveld is further broken up into two units – **Quartz Apronveld** where there is an abundance of quartz rock lying on the surface (an example is Jakkalskop on the town outskirts), or **Gravel Apronveld** which is much-disturbed and is abundant on old raised river terraces where gravel and rocks are common. The latter accounts for most of the Apronveld in the Calitzdorp district and it flanks the deep loams of the bottomlands along the Nel, Gamka and Olifant rivers – the habitat where most of the agriculture around Calitzdorp takes place.

Because of the long history of settlement around Calitzdorp, there is very little Apronveld that is undisturbed and not transformed around the town. But if you can find a pristine patch, there are some plant species that are regarded as indicators of relatively healthy Apronveld. Two of the showy species include **Berkheya cuneata** (Flenniebos) and **Hirpicium integrifolium** (Haarbossie). The indicators of damaged Apronveld are – predictably – much more common around town. They include the very common blue-flowered bulb **Moraea polystachya** (Bloutulp), as well as **Aloe microstigma**, **Cotyledon orbiculata** (Plakkies or Pig's Ears), and even Renosterbos (**Dicerothamnus rhinocerotis**).

So if you walk around Calitzdorp and take note of how common the Bloutulp, *Aloe microstigma* and Plakkies are around town, it tells you how just much the veld around Calitzdorp has been damaged. Sad, but that's the history of our progress.

COMMON CONSTELLATIONS AND THEIR PROMINENT STARS

The constellation of Orion (The Hunter)

(Visible from November to May)

Orion is visible from all over the world and is one of the most well known constellations. The important stars in this constellation are Rigel, Saiph, Betyelgeuse, the Great Nebula and the Three kings (the belt).


The hunters one knee is represented by the star **Rigel.** This star is the seventh brightest star and is 900 light years distant. The other knee is represented by the star **Saiph.**

The three kings or the belt of Orion are represented by three stars called **Mintaka**, Alnilam and Alnitar.

The three stars diagonally from the belt represent the 'sword' of the hunter. The centre faint star in the hunters sword is in fact not a star, but a gas cloud that can be seen with the naked eye. This is called the **Great Nebula** of Orion. It is a small cloud studded with many bright stars, consisting mainly of hydrogen, other gasses and dust.

Betelgeuse (meaning the armpit of the giant)

This is the shoulder star of Orion. It is the twelfth brightest star in our sky. It shows up as a red star (known as a red giant), and is colder than our sun but thousands of times larger.



The three Kings (or belt of Orion)

They are situated at the Celestial equator of the sky, right above the Earth's surface equator. When Orion appears in the East, the three kings indicate true East, and when Orion sets in the West, they indicate true West.

The three stars of Orion's Belt are among the most distant stars that can be seen by the naked eye. Alnitak and Mintaka are at distances of 820 and 915 light years, respectively. Alnilam, the central star of the Belt, is an incredible 1 340 light years away; we see it today as it was around 670 AD, about the time that Britain was being introduced to Christianity.
